

DIY HALLOWEEN COSTUME IDEAS FOR YOUR PUP

- **A Puppuccino** Everyone loves a good puppuccino, so why not turn your puppy into one? For this, adhere a classic coffee logo to a tee, but give it that extra pop for the puppuccino look by adding cotton balls to a barrette to represent that delicious puppy cream!
- **An M&M** Turning your dog into an M&M is a cinch. All you need is a solid primary color shirt and a printer to print out the classic "M". Look for a free "M" template online. Then print and cut out the "M". Use double sided tape to adhere the cut-out to a solid tee.
- **Audrey Hepburn - Breakfast at Tiffanys** For the glamorous pup, find a black tee or dress, and throw on some pearls and lavish costume jewelry with some bling on top. Give them a little blue Tiffany's box and you have a beautiful Audrey-inspired outfit!
- **A Hippie** Got any tie-dye or peace symbols lying around? If so, grab

those and put together an awesome flower child or hippie outfit for your puppy.

- **Borrow from Your Kids** Borrow any wings or capes from your kids' closet to turn your pup into a fairy, butterfly, or superhero.
